More About Matt:

Matt Udermann grew up in Cedar Rapids, Iowa attaining degrees in Management, Marketing, Accounting and Finance. He started and operated a lawn care company, paving the way for graduating debt free from college. He moved to Albany, NY and worked for ARAMARK Facility services managing energy and finance for the New York Office of Mental Health, simultaneously managing operations for Charter Schools and simultaneously earning his MBA as the youngest member of his State University of New York – Albany executive masters class. After graduation, he worked for Maytag Corporation, Whirlpool Corporation and Best Buy World Headquarters over 8 years in various management, finance, merchandising and entrepreneurial roles including overall responsibility for a \$500M business and 25+ employees. Matt has leveraged his big company experiences to successfully transition to entrepreneurial ventures, and currently runs a digital art business and owns a patent for an innovative, proprietary photo frame. Matt was appointed by Randy Maluchnik to the Carver County Library Board in 2018, and is currently serving his second year as President. He is Commissioner for the Chaska Park and Recreation Board, among other civic and volunteer roles. Matt and his wife Krista are

raising two kids (Brooklyn – 4.5, Tenley (6 months) in the Clover Ridge Neighborhood of Chaska. The Udermann's can be seen at town ball games, local restaurants, community kid events and Fish Fry's.

We get asked regularly, 'what does a commissioner do'. Here's a brief overview:

The Carver County Board is made up of 5 commissioners, each representing approximately 20% of County Population (roughly 21K residents). The commissioners guide a \$146.1M overall budget*, comprised of 42.6% of property taxes (and penalties), 43.2% intergovernmental (state, federal, etc. dollars), and the remainder from charges for services, licenses, permits, investment earnings, fines and forfeitures and other revenues. The average homeowner in District 3 pays roughly 1.3% of their home value in taxes made up of City, County and School District. Roughly 30% of those property taxes go to the County (For a house valued at \$322,800, that's \$4,046 total property tax, of which \$1,147 is paid to the County). Yes, it is true, Carver County has the highest median property tax rate in the state.

The collected dollars are allocated as follows: 26% County Sheriff, 20% General Government, 23% Health and Human Services, 14% Public Works, 9% County Attorney Courts & Probation, 7% Library and 1% Land/Water and Environmental. Said differently, roughly 1/3 of County Expenditures are for Physical Infrastructure (roads, bridges, maintenance), 1/3 are for Social Infrastructure (mental health, food assistance, public health) and 1/3 go toward Administration (collecting your taxes, DMV, managing voting, customer facing, etc.)

Under the County umbrella, there are 274 miles of road, 73 bridges, 1,016 acres of public areas, 6 city and 4 express libraries. The county has responsibilities for public safety (patrols, jail, 9-11, courts), personal records (birth, marriage, land purchases), Public Health (disease prevention, immunizations, etc.), Social Services (behavioral health, employment services, elderly/disables transportation, child protection) and Environmental Services (recycling, water management, etc.) Roughly 50% of county dollars go toward human capital (wages, benefits, etc.), across 850+ regular employees and roughly 400 seasonal, contract and temporary employees.
